- \$40.00 10'x28' Outdoor Space with parking for van or car (10' front)
- \$45.00 6'9"x12' Indoor Space in Church Auditorium

- \$25.00 10'x10' Outdoor Middle Court Space
- \$30.00 10'x28' Outdoor Space with parking for van or car (10' front)

**Terms and Conditions:**

- i. Food items must be packaged for consumption at home. Vendors are not permitted to sell ice cream, popcorn, soda, or bottled water at the Festival – these items are available at the Hurley Heritage Society food booths. Exceptions are: homemade candy, jelly, jams, sauces, pickles, and relishes. All food items must be from properly permitted facilities.
- ii. Parking will be provided and assigned to exhibitors (one vehicle per booth). Exhibitors must provide their own tables, chairs, and shade.
- iii. Electricity is available for some indoor vendors only (please specify need). You must supply your own extension cords.
- iv. Exhibitor set-up must be contained within the size of the space purchased.
- v. Set-up time is 7:30 to 9:30 AM. Absolutely no exhibitor admittance for set-up after 10 AM. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- vi. Poles or stakes cannot be driven into the paved surface of the booth space; please protect the asphalt surface.
- vii. Breakdown/close of show is 4 PM. For safety reasons exhibitors are not permitted to breakdown the booths prior to this time.
- viii. The Hurley Heritage Society will not be responsible for damage due to fire, water, theft, vandalism, negligence by the Church, the Hurley Heritage Society, or agents thereof.

**Deadline:**

This application must be returned, along with full payment for **Early Sign Up Discount by June 1, 2010.** Space is available on a first-come, first-served basis and will not be held without payment. A \$10.00 refund fee will be charged for cancellations received prior to August 1, 2010; cancellations after August 1 are not refundable. A confirmation letter with booth and parking assignments will be mailed to all participating exhibitors before August 10, 2010.
